Dates: June 23rd – October 27th

Hours: 9:30am – 1:00 pm

Location: Legion Park, Algoma

Cost: One 10' x 10' Stall - \$150

Two 10' x 10' Stall - \$250

Half Season - \$75 (June 23rd-August 25th OR Sept 1- October 27)

Daily Stall \$15 (Does not accumulate toward ½ or full season.)

General Guidelines:

- Fill out the application and submit by May 14th, 2019.
- Mail all required forms and payment. Vendor fees are nonrefundable after June 1st.
- Acceptance letters will be sent no later than May 28th.
- All vendors will be required to attend a vendor meeting June 4th at 6:00PM.
- Stall numbers and placement map will be available at the vendor meeting along with event calendar.
- Vendors may not sublet their space or allow another vendor to sell in their booth.
- Vendors are responsible for collecting and reporting any applicable sales tax.
- All legal-for-trade scales should be approved by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture.

- Vendors are responsible for all required licenses and corresponding fees.
- Examples of items approved for sale without obtaining a license: homegrown vegetables, fruits, fresh and dried flowers, fresh herbs, and handmade crafts.
- Examples of item requiring a license and/or that must originate from a licensed operation: processed food, cheese, eggs, dried herbs, poultry, and meats.

VENDOR RULES AND REGULATIONS

Produce Vendor criteria for uncut vegetables, fruits and cut flowers

- Must be locally grown (except peaches and blueberries) and cultivated by vendor.
- Vendor must own or lease the property where the produce is grown.
- Buying, reselling, and sharing of produce amongst vendors is prohibited.
- Organic vendors must have proof of certification.
- All vendors must have a seller's permit from the State of Wisconsin.
- If selling products by weight, an approved scale is required.

Processed Food Vendors criteria for prepackaged foods

- All foods must be processed by vendor.
- Product must be made in a licensed and inspected establishment.
- All vendors must have a seller's permit from the State of Wisconsin.
- If selling products by weight, an approved scale is required.

Prepared Food Vendor criteria for foods prepared on-site

- Food sold must be prepared on-site by the vendor.
- Only one vendor selling the same type of product will be accepted, first come first-served.
- A Temporary Restaurant Permit from Kewaunee County Health Department is required.
- All vendors must have a seller's permit from the State of Wisconsin.
- If selling products by weight, an approved scale is required.

Art and Craft Vendor criteria for handcrafted and homemade products.

- Items for sale must be of original design or creation.
- Items for sale must be made by the vendor selling them.
- All vendors must have a seller's permit from the State of Wisconsin.
- Must sent picture of items in with application
